The Student Intern works under the direction of the Transition Advisor and is responsible for assisting in the implementation of activities and programs that contribute to effective student transition into the University culture. The Student Intern is expected to be an ambassador for La Trobe University and specifically for the College of ASSC, being a positive and exemplary role model to other students and in representing the College in both internal and external events.

Position Context

The Student Intern will be responsible for assisting the STAR team in the development and implementation and management of the various transition programs and activities, including a student blog. The opportunity is expected to provide 'student perspective' input and feedback on transition initiatives that will improve student engagement and the overall student experience in relation to the student blog.

Duties may include:

- Research, including desktop, focus groups and surveying that assists in the development or evaluation of the student blog.
- Contribute to the development of a student communications plan, including initiating, monitoring and responding to students in an online forum.
- Creation of web-based content that supports student transition, based on sound knowledge of the issues and needs of University of La Trobe students.
- In collaboration with staff reflect on current services/programs and raise issues as well as contribute ideas for continual improvement.
- Conduct or design surveys that collect student feedback (where appropriate)
- Undertake other duties commensurate with the scope of the internship as required by the Transition Advisor.
